

Quaker Terms

Clerk - The head of a committee, also the person who presides at meetings for worship with attention to business.

Clerking Committee -

Continuing Revelation - The belief that God still speaks to persons directly today.

Forum

Hold in the Light - a way of expressing a concern for God's guidance and care for a person.

Meeting for Worship - Held weekly,

Meeting for Worship with Attention to Business - Held monthly, where the business of the meeting is handled.

Meeting for Worship with Attention to Healing - Meets monthly (usually) to hold themselves and others in the Light.

Ministry & Counsel

Monthly Meeting - A group of people who have established a community that generally meets every week for meeting for worship and once a month for meeting for business. Generally, the monthly meeting is considered the foundation of Quaker life.

Recording Clerk - Takes minutes of the meeting for business.
